

BRIDESMAID CHEAT SHEET

Prewedding

- May help bride shop for her dress
- Unless an out-of-town maid, goes on at least one bridesmaid-dress-shopping trip
- Go for fittings and alterations as needed
- Help with wedding-planning errands
- Help plan shower and/or bachelorette party

At ceremony

- Along with other bridesmaids, walk single file in the procession
- Stand in line in front of altar or stage, or sit in front pew with other bridesmaids
- Walk in recessional paired with a groomsmen

At reception

- May be announced at reception
- May sit at head table
- Take part in first dance (if entire wedding party is involved)

GROOMSMAN CHEAT SHEET

Prewedding

- May help groom choose formalwear
- Go for fittings and alterations as needed
- Attend couple's shower, if there will be one
- Help plan, and attend, bachelor party

At ceremony

- If you will also serve as an usher, stand at door ready to escort guests to their seats
- Stand with groom, best man, and other groomsmen at the altar or stage as ceremony is about to begin
- Stand in line or sit in front pew with other groomsmen during ceremony
- Walk in recessional paired with a bridesmaid

At reception

- May be announced at reception
- May sit at head table
- Take part in first dance (if entire wedding party is involved)

Other _____

FLOWER GIRL CHEAT SHEET

- Attend shower with mother
- Walk in processional directly before the bride (possibly with ring bearer), carrying a bouquet, wearing a floral head wreath, and/or scattering flower petals from a basket
- Sit with parents during the ceremony and at the reception

Other _____

RING BEARER CHEAT SHEET

- Walk in processional directly before the bride (possibly with flower girl), carrying a ring pillow with the "wedding bands" (most couples entrust the real ones to the honor attendants)
- Sit with parents during the ceremony and at the reception
