- Based on when your dress is expected to come in (probably within three to six months), schedule a first fitting. Date: _____ / _____ / _____ Time: _____
- About a month after you order, call the shop to confirm your delivery date.
- Make a list of all accessories you'll need, and start to purchase them (you'll want lingerie and shoes in time for your first fitting):
 - Bustier/bra
 - Garter
 - Slip
 - Stockings
 - Petticoat
 - Crinoline
 - Pumps
 - Sandals
 - Wrap
 - Purse
 - Gloves
 - Jewelry
- Search for accessories at www.TheKnot.com/accessories.
- When the dress comes in, go try it on and check it over carefully. Make sure it's the style you ordered and that nothing is damaged.
- Have your first fitting. (The salesperson or seamstress will pin the dress in places you need it taken in.)
- Schedule a second fitting (when you'll try on the altered dress to make sure it fits). Date: _____ / _____ / _____ Time: _____
- If you haven't yet, decide on a headpiece.
- At your second fitting, determine whether your dress fits you properly. (If it does, the store will press it for you and you can take it home.)
- If more alterations are necessary, schedule a third fitting. (Two are usually sufficient.) Date: _____ / _____ / _____ Time: _____
