

## Renting the Formalwear Checklist

- Along with the best man, try on styles you like and decide whether the groom's outfit will be slightly different from the rest of the men's.
- Make final decision(s) on your formalwear.
- Get measured and have the best man and other groomsmen come in to do the same; have out-of-town groomsmen send their measurements.
- Decide what size(s) to order. Ask to see the manufacturer's sizing chart yourself. Choose the size that fits each groomsman's largest measurement.
- Review your receipt for the following critical points:
  - Name and contact information for you and the store
  - Your wedding date
  - Complete description of what you're renting:
